

## Call for Manuscripts for the 2020 *AILACTE Journal*, Volume XVII

Each year the Association of Independent Liberal Arts Colleges for Teacher Education (AILACTE) publishes a peer-reviewed journal. The goal of the *Journal* is to disseminate scholarly work that enhances the work of *teacher education professionals in independent, liberal arts colleges and universities*.

The 2020 *Journal* is not a theme-based edition. Manuscripts may address any issue that will enhance the work of teacher educators in a liberal arts context. Appropriate topics for the *Journal* include teaching and learning strategies, candidate and program assessment, diversity and inclusion, policy changes, etc. Submissions are not limited to research studies, but manuscripts that are grounded in literature and supported by data will be given stronger consideration.

Manuscripts are due **June 19, 2020**, and must follow APA guidelines, 6<sup>th</sup> Edition. Please refer to the *AILACTE Journal* [Submission Guidelines and Checklist](#) for the additional *AILACTE Journal* requirements.
