

Journal Editorial Review Board – Responsibilities

- Board members sign Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality forms. They do not discuss the manuscripts they review with anyone other than the editor(s).
- Board members complete manuscript reviews that are objective, unbiased, and fair. Reviewers state suggestions and criticism in a constructive manner and offer an abundance of comments that will help the author(s) in understanding the decision about their manuscript and in improving their work.
- Board members serve on an indefinite basis as long as their reviews are appropriate, timely, and helpful to author(s).
- Board members provide input to the editors on a variety of topics.
